Theatre District

The Theatre District is home to New York City's entertainment and Broadway shows, full of life, lights and excitement. Staying in and around the Theater District is any Theater enthusiasts dream. Triomphe restaurant in The Iroquois Hotel is a hidden gem offering a memorable creation of food to patrons heading to Broadway. Shows like the Tony Award winner, *Jersey Boys*, a story behind Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons are just a short walk from Triomphe's front door.

The craft cocktail scene is quite spirited in Manhattan, and tops on the go-to list is Rene Hidalgo's Lantern's Keep in the Theatre District. This spring, the gem of a cocktail bar debuts a Cobblers section of its menu, a style of drink pre-dating "cocktails". A highlight from this menu is the sherry cobbler, which was the most popular drink in the 1850s, made with sherry, fruit and sugar. Another new addition to the Lantern's Keep menu is the hot house, made with gin, lemon juice, sugar and absinthe, and perfectly epitomizing the freshness and simplicity of this historical concoction.
